Welcome to the Young Shakespeareans 2010!

As always, we will be offering creative journeys through Shakespeare's language and stories, while exploring acting, voice and movement for the stage. Our extremely popular summer workshops program continues to flourish, and I am pleased to be able to update you on a few of our new and exciting developments.

Last year saw the addition of a Young Shakespeareans workshop in Delta, in cooperation with the Delta Arts Council, we are happy to announce the expansion of this outreach in 2010. This year, junior (ages 8 to 13) and senior workshops (ages 13 to 18) will now be available. Workshops will be held at the Tsawwassen Arts Centre. Registration will be handled through the Bard office. In addition, Young Shakespearean workshops will also be held at the Shadbolt Centre in Burnaby. Registration for these workshops will be handled through the Shadbolt. Registration there begins March 2nd. Please visit our website: www.bardonthebeach.org/youth.html, for information and links.

Last year also saw the implementation of a bursary program for our summer workshops. These bursaries provided assistance for numerous families, enabling them to join the Young Shakespeareans. Thanks to many generous donors, this fund continues to grow. If you would like to contribute to the bursary program, there is an opportunity to do so on the Young Shakespeareans registration form or on the Bard website. We happily welcome all donations, and gifts of at least \$20 will receive a charitable tax receipt. Bursary applications for the Vanier Park programs are now closed. Applications for the Delta program only can be downloaded from the website.

You may notice an increase in workshop fees this year. While there have been nominal increases over the years, the implementation of the HST has added an extra 7% to our fees.

And finally, we are thrilled to announce that all Young Shakespeareans will receive a t-shirt as part of their registration! This will give us all a lasting memento of our time together. We look forward to seeing them worn throughout the summer, and in our various communities during the rest of the year.
